Dear Ms. Dortch,

On April 26, 2022, I met with Ethan Lucarelli, Legal Advisor, Wireless and Public Safety to Chairwoman Jessica Rosenworcel, together with Trey Hanbury and Tom Peters of Jenner & Block.

During the meeting, I expressed confidence that 5G mobile broadband operations, non-geostationary orbit (NGSO) fixed-satellite service, and Ku-band Direct Broadcast Satellite (DBS) operations can share the 12 GHz band and coexist in the band. I encouraged the Commission to act swiftly to authorize 5G operations in the 12.2–12.7 GHz band. Finally, I explained how valuable the 12 GHz band is for 5G operations and added that deploying 5G in the 12 GHz band would deliver meaningful economic and public interest benefits to American consumers. I encouraged the Commission to expeditiously allow 5G deployment in the 12 GHz band.
